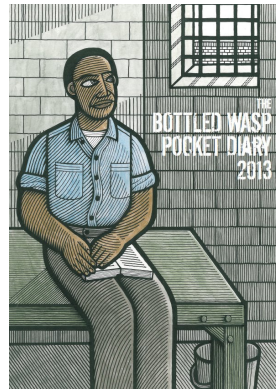
This new radical diary has been created as a European alternative to the U.S.-centric Slingshot Diary, and is designed to fundraise for prisoner support projects.

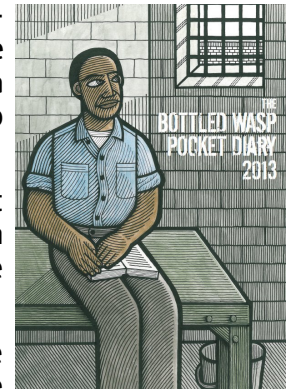
